MINUTES OF THE PRIEST RIVER CITY COUNCIL - 06/21/22

SPECIAL MEETING

<u>OPENING</u> – Council President Turner called to order the special meeting of the City Council at 5:30 pm on Tuesday, June 21, 2022, at the Priest River City Hall Council Chambers, 552 High Street, Priest River, Idaho.

2. ROLL CALL

3. PUBLIC HEARING

The City of Priest River received an Idaho Community Development Block Grant in the amount of \$500,000 from the Idaho Department of Commerce. This funding is allocated to the State of Idaho from the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development. These funds are currently being used for water system improvements.

The hearing will include a review of project activities and accomplishments to date, a summary of all expenditures to date, a general description of remaining work and any changes made to the scope of work, budget, schedule, location or beneficiaries.

Council President Turner opened the public hearing at 5:31 pm. Nancy Mabile from Panhandle Area Council was in attendance and presented the current project status, construction updates from the project engineer, remaining work and anticipated schedule, and a budget review of all funding sources.
